Purpose of the Challenge:

To enable the industry as well as observers to view the level of skills taught within the public secondary and post-secondary education systems, and to encourage interaction between the various sectors. This relationship will help ensure that the skills gained by young hairstylists at all levels of training are geared towards the demands of the beauty industry.

Skills & Knowledge to be Tested:

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following tests:

Ladies Creative Day Style With Color Enhancement

Ladies Hair by Night with Hairpieces and Ornamentation

Men's Hairstyle Current Trend fashion Cut, with Color Enhancement

No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical tests.

Safety Instructions:

Competitors must demonstrate aptitude in safety awareness.

***Please note that we will have first aid kits available on site.**

1 female Mannequin
1 male mannequin
Chemical Colours
Bowl and Brush (or applicator bottle)
Colour Remover
Styling Products
Shoulders and Drapery (or clothing and jewellery – not mandatory)
Own Makeup for touch up only (make up for mannequin pre-done)
All Styling/Working Tools
Clips
Cutting Tools & Razors
Blow Dryer
Curling & Flat Irons

Clothing Requirements:

Clothing should be clean and comfortable as would be worn by staff working in a modern hair salon as well as any protective clothing as needed
Closed toe shoes are mandatory.

Judging / Distribution of Marks

Any communication between audience and competitor during contest times may be seen as coaching and could result in demerits.

**TEST #1 - LADIES CREATIVE
CREATIVE HAIRSTYLE WITH COLOR ENHANCEMENT**

Time limit: 4 hours

Color:

Mannequin may be pre-coloured using **ONE** color technique. For example, competitor has a choice of complete solid base colour, bleach, or foil.

There must be a minimum of 2 colors used

During the competition all colour techniques are allowed.

The choice of colour is free.

No colour sprays, gels or mousses are allowed

Note: The hairpieces for test #2 can be colored cut and dried during test #1 (can be dried in test #1 or test #2). They must be presented lying flat on the table (minimum 2 hairpieces maximum 3 pieces)

Haircut:

A **minimum** of 1 inch **MUST** be cut during the competition

The style is of the competitors own choice

Blow-Dry:

Competitors must perform a blow-dry only, on wet hair

All styling tools and products are allowed except color sprays, gels or mousses

Wigs, hairpieces, and bobby pins are forbidden

Set-up and Draping:

Jewellery and Clothing

Make up touch up

Assessment:

Colour enhancement 3 points

Finished overall look 4 points

Cut 3 points

TEST #2 – LADIES' HAIR BY NIGHT with HAIRPIECES and ORNAMENTAION

Time limit: 1.5 hour

The competitors will use the creative style from test #1 to transform into hair by night with the addition of longer hairpieces and ornamentation.

- This competition is an elegant evening style
- The mannequin from test #1 remains on the floor unchanged
- Prior to the start of the competition scrutineers will check if there is a minimum of 2 hairpieces to a maximum of 3 hairpieces
- The competitor must thoroughly brush the whole head when given the order
- Competitors can, if they wish, wet, shape, blow dry or style the hair
- Only texturizing the ends of the hairpieces on the finished style is permitted (no change to original style of cut from test #1)
- Longer hair must be integrated in order to emphasize the fashionable evening character, but also in order to present a new longer appearing style (including 2-3 hairpieces)
- Ornaments made from hair or hair-like fibers are forbidden

Ornamentation:

Must compliment the design

Ornamentation **MUST NOT** cover more than 50% of the whole head

Set-up and Draping:

Jewellery and Clothing

Make up touch-up

Points will be awarded for:

Inspiration and creativity

Balance

Clean finish

Balance and clean finish	5
Ornamentation: design and integration	5

TEST # 3 – MEN’S HAIRSTYLING
CURRENT FASHION CUT, COLOURATION, HAIRSTYLE

This haircut must be an up to date current trend style worn by today’s contemporary fashionable man, using any combination of lengths from long to short. Demerits will be given to Avant – Garde hairstyles.

Men’s Colour to be completed prior to the competition

Mannequin will be pre-coloured to competitor’s choice of color.
Colours must be a harmonious graduation of two or more colours and must represent a masculine impression
No coloured sprays, gels or mousse allowed
The beard may be coloured and pre-cut (but will not be marked)

Haircut: (45 minutes)

Mannequin may be pre-cut. A **MINIMUM** of 1 inch **MUST** be cut during the competition
All cutting tools are allowed
Finished cut be not be more than 4’’ in the nape
No restrictions on haircutting techniques

Hairstyle: (30 minutes)

All styling products and tools are permitted
