CARPENTRY (Post - Secondary) 2008

Contest Length: 6 hrs

Purpose of the Challenge:

To evaluate each contestants' ability to organize and execute a given work load safely and accurately using generally accepted carpentry practices.

Skills & Knowledge to be Tested:

- The contest will include accurate layout using basic geometry , common rafter layout, and cedar shingle installation
- Demonstrate ability and competency in reading blueprints and specifications
- Safe use of hand and power tools
- The project will consist of General Framing and rafter
- The project may include finishing carpentry
- The demonstration of sound work practices and assembly techniques in the building of a simple project to an acceptable standard
- Quality, accuracy and thoroughness of workmanship
- Ability to complete an assignment in a given time
- General work attitude

Specific Requirements:

- The contestant will produce a specified project to acceptable standards as determined by the judges.
- All measurements in metric and imperial

Safety Instructions:

Safety awareness/requirements will be maintained at minimum industry standards at all times. A contestant will not be allowed to compete without the safety equipment noted on this document. WCB regulations will be in effect.

- CSA approved safety footwear (no running shoes)

- Eye protection (CSA certified glasses or goggles)
- Hearing Protection (Deci-damps)
- Suitable work clothes (No muscle shirts or shorts - long pants only)

- Carpenter belt or Overalls
- Tape measure
- Hammer
- Chalk Line
- Block plane
- Chisel set
- Utility Knife w/ Blades
- Pencils and erasers, Calculator (non- programmable)
- 24"-36" Carpenters Level
- Framing Square
- Speed square or combination square
- Hand saw

Any other equipment or tools may be brought which you are use to using, but must be approved by the chairman at contest time.
